

Terms & conditions in connection to deposit payment and refund

Signing up for Danish classes

If you are required to pay a deposit, you will not be able to start your Danish course until Speak has received your payment. The deposit is DKK 2000,-.

The deposit is valid for the module you are referred to. If you wish to continue to the next module, you are not required to make a new payment if you have passed the module within the deadline (your original deposit will be transferred to the next module).

If you have not completed the module within the deadline, your original deposit is lost. If you wish to continue to the next module, you must pay the deposit again.

Refund

You can ask to have the deposit refunded to you under the following conditions:

- You have passed one of the final examinations for Danish education (PD1, PD2 or PD3) within 9 months in the final module (see table).
- You have concluded the module you were referred to with a test within the deadline (see table).

Forfeiture of deposit

- You will lose your deposit, if you do not pass the module test or the final exam within the deadline (see table).
- You will also lose your deposit, if you stop your Danish education and have not passed the module test/final exam within the deadline (see table).

Payment conditions

Payment is online via a safe connection. You need to use a payment card. The amount will at the earliest be withdrawn from your account the day you receive our confirmation e-mail. The payment will only be withdrawn from your account provided your bank has approved the transaction. In case your bank does not approve the transaction, we will not be able to offer you a class.
